**TEN YEARS OF PUBLISHING. . . TIME TO
 PUBLISH A COMPREHENSIVE INDEX!**

After ten years, this issue completes Volume I of the newsletter. Below we respond to two common reader questions: "Why don't you publish names and addresses with the Queries?" and "When are you going to publish an Index to the newsletter?"

As we wrap up our 10th year of publishing *Austins of America*, we want to thank you, the hundreds of readers and researchers who have contributed your Austin families research to *Austins of America*. By generously sharing your information through the newsletter, you have helped many others – now and in the future – in searching for their Austin roots. Thanks to your support and “passing the word” to others, in just ten years we have grown to become the largest national organization serving Austin family researchers, and your research contributions have made the *Austins of America* files the largest Austin genealogical database available anywhere!

With a high-speed computerized retrieval system for finding information in the *Austins of America* files, we are able to answer many reader queries. We publish the rest, and other readers may respond to them through *Austins of America*. We forward responses to querists, and send querists’ names and addresses to respondents. Publishing these names and addresses with the queries would take up additional newsletter space, and we would not learn of others interested in those Austin lines. Also, several querists have died though the years, and dozens of others have moved. By responding to the queries through *Austins of America*, you are sure of getting a querist’s most current address available. . . we recently forwarded a response to a querist who had moved three times in the last four years!

This fall we plan to publish an Index to these first 310 pages. The Index will be available to readers, and included in the bound Volume I of *Austins of America*. It will comprehensively include all person and place names, plus some time and geographic information. Frustrated looking up ‘John Austin’ and finding dozens of them? The Index will enable you to narrow down your candidates, to sort them out both in time and geographically!

We welcome Sally Austin Day of Livonia, Michigan, as a new Associate Editor. Sally has frequently contributed articles and information – her efforts have benefited many. She joins the *Austins of America* Staff at a bright time, just as we begin a second decade of service to Austin family researchers!
